WSSDA has updated this model policy to reflect new federal guidance allowing school districts to set the threshold for a micro-purchase without seeking bids up to \$50,000 if the school district meets certain requirements, such as being identified as low-risk during the most recent audit. OSPI has issued guidance stating that a district that wants to use this higher micro-purchase threshold must revise this policy accordingly.

6230 BP Relations with Vendors

Excerpt from Policy and Legal News: Before your district enters a third-party receipting contract, your board must adopt language in a board policy that permits crowdfunding and third-party receipting. WSSDA has revised Model Policy 6230 to include this language. Although Model Policy 6230 is a Discretionary policy, the new language is required if your board wishes to contract for third-party receipting services.
