Children ages 1-18 and K-12 students who are not physically attending school in the buildings can receive meals from our grab & go station in front of the high school from 8 AM to 11 AM. Grab & go meals are available on all days students are attending school Mon., Tues., Thur., Fri. When you get meals from the grab & go station on Tuesday, children will be provided 2 days' worth of meals to cover Wednesday. This service has been extended through the entire 2020/21 school year by the USDA. Also, per USDA, you can receive meals from any school district, whether you attend the district or not.

Box Tops - Scan Your Receipts and Collect Them Now!

Did you know that for every box top that is turned in, the school receives \$0.10. Over the years TES has received thousands of dollars just by saving box tops!

Box Tops for education has changed how they collect box tops. You have to download the app and scan your receipts and the money will automatically be added to the schools account. Receipts have to be scanned within 14 days of purchase to count. If you don't want to download the app but have a receipt to be scanned, feel free to come into the office and we will scan it for you. If you have the traditional box tops you can still turn them in. Please turn any traditional box tops into the office.
